#### Trail Notes (Clockwise from trailhead)

Marker 1 Near Park boundary on jeep road;Trail turns north on another jeep road

Marker 2 Single track starts: CAUTION !

Marker 6 Trail makes a sharp right and goes up ravine

Marker & Trail goes left down arroyo; Shortcut One goes right, crosses arroyo and left up jeep road

Marker 9 Trail goes right, leaves arroyo and merges with jeep road at Marker 10

With jeep road at Marker 10
Marker 11 Single track starts ahead just around bend to

right
Marker 12 Trail joins jeep road just east of old fence

crossing, goes up road toward mountain
Marker 13 Trail exits road left as single track: Shortcut Two
goes up road

Marker 14 Trail goes left, down jeep road: Shortcut Three begins right, up jeep road

Marker 16 Trail angles off road on right, drops down into and crosses arroyo at Marker 17

Marker 18 Single track crosses jeep road; Shortcut Four goes toward mountain on road

Marker 19 Trail crosses Vinton Canyon Road; Turn toward mountain for Shortcut Five

Marker 20 Trail exits road left as single track, goes about 2.2 miles before reaching Marker 27

Marker 27 Trail joins jeep road, turns toward mountain

Marker 28 Trail forks: Right fork follows arroyo south about 0.3 miles and exits right at Marker 30, Left fork heads north across arroyo, exits onroad, follows road toward mountain about 0.5 miles, exits left on single track to State Line, about 0.75 miles north

Marker 34 Trail crosses Vinton Canyon Road again: Shortcut Five goes right

Marker 35 Trail exits road on left toward mountain as single track; Shortcut Four follows road west

Marker 36 Single track merges with road; Very sharp right on road for Shortcut Three

Marker 39 Trail goes left as single track; Shortcut Two follows road away from mountain

Marker 41 Trail angles right across arroyo, makes a sharp left as it exits arroyo and then turns right as it joins old road

Marker 42 Trail joins road and goes left toward mountain; Shortcut One goes right

Marker 44 Top of Nature Trail climb and pavement

Marker 45 Single track exits paved loop on left

Marker 47 Trail brushes Nature Walk/equipment parking lot

Marker 48-49 Trail enters and exits parking area east of shop/storage building

Marker 50 Trail rejoins pavement, turns left, then veers right and upward to marker 51

Marker 51 Trail enters Lower Sunset trailhead/picnic parking area

#### Safety Tips For Bikers

From Marker 2 to Marker 8 is the most technical section of the trail and is not recommended for beginning riders

Bring water. There is no potable water available in the park.

Bring repair and first aid kits. Bring extra tubes and a pump.

Bike with a friend.

Know your limits and slways waar your helmet.
