- Camping by permit only
- Watch for snakes
- Watch out for poison ivy
- Do not make new trails
- Make trail improvements only with permission of Trail Steward
- Report illegal, suspicious, or discourteous activity or hazards to Trail Steward
- All group events must be approved and scheduled with Trail Steward
- Picnic area is available on a "first come" basis unless reserved for group events
